Dear Stakeholder:

The Tulsa District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is conducting an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for Federal actions at Eufaula Lake, Oklahoma in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969.

This is to inform you the EIS will address impacts associated with an update to the Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) and supplement to the Master Plan (MP) for Eufaula Lake, Oklahoma. The EIS will likewise evaluate alternatives and environmental impacts associated with specific proposals for recreational development facilities on Federal lands at Eufaula Lake as identified through the SMP update and MP supplement process. The last updates to the SMP and MP at Eufaula Lake occurred in 1998 and 1977, respectively.

A notice of intent (NOI) to prepare an EIS for this action was published in the Federal Register on April 25, 2011. A public scoping workshop for this action will be held on Thursday, June 2, 2011, from 6:00 to 9:00 PM at the Eufaula Middle School gymnasium, 1711 West J.M. Bailey Highway, Eufaula, Oklahoma. The workshop will have no formal presentation with an open house, come and go format. The workshop will have display information, handouts and Corps personnel to answer questions and receive comments. We welcome your attendance at this workshop.
